MATTER HITS STRIDE

• The protocols — pick wisely

FUTURE-PROOF

Matter

Cross-vendor standard. Apple + Google + Amazon + Samsung. The convergence layer.

Thread

Low-power mesh transport for battery devices. Matter rides on Thread.

Mesh

Zigbee

Mature mesh. Hue, Aqara. Needs a hub. Reliable.

Legacy OK

Z-Wave

Pro security ecosystem. Strong encryption. Hub required.

Security

• Platforms — pick one primary

Apple Home

Best privacy + local control. iPhone household = path of least resistance.

Google Home

Best voice assistant. Strong cameras (Nest). Cross-platform.

Alexa

Largest device ecosystem. Cheapest speakers. Cloud-dependent.

Home Assistant

Open-source, local-first, maximum power. Real work to administer.

Power

PRO TIP

Smart plugs are the cheapest, most useful first buy. Validate the whole smart-home idea on a \$15 plug before going deeper.

DON'T

Mix three platforms hoping for unity. Pick one primary; the rest are integrations, not equals.

BUY IN THIS ORDER

- 1 Smart plugs**
Cheap. Anything plug-in becomes smart.
- 2 Smart lighting**
Switches over bulbs for primary fixtures.
- 3 Motion / contact sensors**
Foundation of automations.
- 4 Smart lock + doorbell**
Grade 1 front, Grade 2 secondary.
- 5 Thermostat + cameras + speakers**
As needs emerge.

Highest ROI
- 3 Security**
Locks, doorbells, cameras
